

2016 Anthology Guidelines

The guidelines for submission for the 2016 Anthology are as follows:

Deadline: December 31. Sooner is better.

Method: All work must be submitted via email.

Submissions:

Members who want to submit pieces in a variety of genre should limit themselves to one piece per genre except for poetry. The editor reserves the right to choose pieces that best fit the entire anthology from multiple selections from one author.

If a member wants to submit work in only one genre, the following restrictions will apply:

- Up to five poems per member
- Two shorter non-fiction or fiction pieces per member
- One drama of any length, but one-acts preferred

Length will not be restricted, but members are asked to submit chapters or stand alone sections from longer works. If two longer works (over 8-10 pages) are submitted, the editor will choose between them.

Illustrations will be added again this year. Authors may submit their own photographs or non-copy-protected illustrations (no clip art). Art by authors would be gratefully accepted. Suggestions would be appreciated.

Font and size: Set the side margins for 1.25 to allow for spiral holes on either side.

Bio: **Please** include a third-person author bio of not more than 150 words.

Mac users: Calibri 12 point is what I use for the Anthology; if you write using it, with 1.25 margins, I won't have to change anything. Otherwise, use Ariel and 12 point font.

PC people: Write in Ariel, 12 point font, with margins of 1.25. I will make the change to the font I use in Pages.
