When housing is reserved, PW guarantees that rental to the provider ; if you cannot attend, that housing cost still has to be covered. In an effort to keep our conferences as affordable as possible, it is the policy of Peninsula Writers not to pass this expense to other members, but to collect the funds from the original registrant if a replacement registrant cannot be found. This policy holds true for those receiving scholarship funds for housing. If you have received a scholarship, but are unable to attend the conference, your scholarship will be voided. If a replacement registrant cannot be found, you will be responsible for the full portion of your housing costs.


